Notes:

- Attendance Rate = Total Days Attendance/Total Possible Number of Enrolment Days expressed as a percentage.
- For students identified as attending from specific communities, only data for days the student resided within the community are included in calculations.
- Data should be used to indicate broad trends only. The Term 1 comparison is with the corresponding term in the previous year.
- Includes full and part day absences for full-time students only.
- Includes all students, Indigenous and Non-Indigenous.
- Student counts at community level are of unique students. Primary and Secondary student counts are of unique students within sector.
- From Term 1 2012, Hopevale State School, Western Cape College - Aurukun and Western Cape College - Coen became part of Cape York Aboriginal Australian Academy and changed their names to Hopevale Campus of CYAAA, Aurukun Campus of CYAAA and Coen Campus of CYAAA respectively.
- In December 2012, the Aurukun Campus of CYAAA changed from a PY - 12 to a PY - 07 school.
- From 2015 Year 7 moved from a Primary School year level to Secondary School for all schools in Queensland.
- In August 2016, the Aurukun Campus of CYAAA changed from a PY - 06 to a PY - 08 school.
- Caution should be used when examining the percentage changes in attendance for both Coen and Mossman Gorge communities. Both these communities have relatively small numbers of students and a small numerical change can result in a large percentage difference in the overall attendance figures.

Data Considerations:

- * The transition of Queensland schools to the 'OneSchool' IT system has resulted in a variation in the calculation of student attendance. Effective from January 2013 statistics are being calculated on the attendance history of each student on each day, irrespective of enrolment history. Students with high mobility will now be accurately reflected in student attendance reporting. **DETE advise that the student attendance series based on the new methodology is not directly comparable to the prior methodology.**
- ** Aurukun Community data before 2013 includes primary and secondary students attending Aurukun Campus of Cape York Aboriginal Australian Academy (PY - 12). From Term 1 2013, Aurukun community data includes primary students attending the Aurukun Campus of CYAAA and secondary students attending Western Cape College - Aurukun Secondary Campus.
- *** In Term 2 2016, Aurukun Campus of CYAAA was closed from 11-18 May (inclusive) and again from 26-30 May (inclusive). An alternative education program was offered for the remainder of the term covering 31 May to 24 June. Attendance at this alternative program was lower than the normal rates for this term.
- **** Effective from 2013 Aurukun Secondary Sector schooling transitioned to the Alternative Secondary Pathway (ASP) program facilitated by Western Cape College. Effective from 1 January 2015 DET closed the ASP program.
- Terms 1, 2 and 3 2013 Attendance rates for WCC - Aurukun Secondary Campus are withdrawn from the data table because administrative processes used at the school during that period resulted in attendance rates that are not comparable over time or with other schools. The records collected from Terms 1, 2 and 3 indicate attendance rates of 89.6%, 92.5% and 71.3% respectively. Using these data may result in invalid interpretations of the student attendance at this Campus.
- ***** Mossman Gorge Community attendance includes attendance for school-identified students from Mossman State School and Mossman State High School.
