

Right to Information - Personal Information Amendment Application Form

Please read the following information before proceeding with your application.

The purpose of this form is to allow applications for information under the *Right to Information Act 2009* (RTI Act). Before filling out the form, check with the FRC if you haven't already, about whether you are able to amend your information informally.

This form is also available online at www.frcq.org.au should you wish to download and complete electronically. Using this form is optional but it asks for the information the FRC needs to consider your application.

You can apply for amendment of your personal information if you have accessed the personal information and believe it is inaccurate, incomplete, outdated or misleading. There is no fee, but you must provide evidence of identity (ID). If applying on someone's behalf, you must provide evidence of authorisation to act and their ID.

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3. Evidence of identity

To apply to amend your personal information, you must provide evidence of ID with your application or submit it shortly after to proceed. If applying on behalf of someone else, provide their ID and evidence of your authorization to act on that person's behalf.

Applying:

- **by post** – include the completed application form and, if required, a certified copy of ID and the agent authority.
- **in person** – deliver the application and, if required, show original ID and agent authority to the RTI officer.
- **by email** – email the application form and, if required, a certified copy of ID and the agent authority.

Note: Copies of some documents must be certified by a lawyer or notary public, a pharmacist, a commissioner for declarations or a justice of the peace.

Examples of documents that may provide sufficient evidence of identity include:

- current driver's licence
- digital driver's licence
- current passport
- birth certificate
- copy of a prisoner's identity card certified by a corrective services officer
- statutory declaration of an individual who has known the applicant for at least one year. (A statutory declaration form can be downloaded at www.publications.qld.gov.au/dataset/statutory-declaration-affidavit)
